**Registration Procedure:**

Registrations will be accepted from **March 1 through March 27, 2010**. Campers will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, **based on the number of volunteers available and according to postmark. *Priority will be given to girls whose parent/guardian is volunteering. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged if form is postmarked after March 27, 2010.*** If your form is postmarked after March 20 and you do not include the \$10.00 late fee, your registration form will not be processed until the late fee is received. You will receive a confirmation postcard when your registration is received. **ONLY REGISTRATIONS MAILED TO THE ADDRESS BELOW WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

**DO NOT** send registrations to the Girl Scout Center, but to the address above. All registrations received at the Girl Scout Center will be forwarded to the appropriate day camp on a weekly basis.

We reserve the right to close units when *Safety-Wise* girl/adult ratios are reached.

**Financial Assistance Application:** Full financial assistance will not be awarded. **Cookie Dough:** Cookie dough may be used as payment. Mail cookie dough with registration.

**Refund Policy:** Money may be refunded for the following reasons ONLY:

1. Moving out of town.
2. Illness or exposure to a communicable disease.
3. Required attendance at summer school.
4. Camp capacity is reached and no other camp is attended.

**Staff:** Our day camp is staffed entirely by adult volunteers. **WITHOUT VOLUNTEERS, THERE CAN BE NO CAMP.** Moms, dads, aunts, uncles, grandparents and other adult friends are welcome! A Girl Scouting background is not necessary. Volunteers are required to complete a volunteer application and a background check and to attend a training session to prepare you for your role at camp. Your preschool age children and boys may attend day camp in their own units. **If you are interested in volunteering, please check the appropriate space on the Adult Volunteer Information Form.** If you volunteer you will be expected to be at camp on your assigned day(s). Failure to comply may affect your daughter's future day camp registration.

**Trainings:** Training is **required** for **ALL** adult volunteers and camp assistants.

**Camp Assistants:** Saturday, May 15, 2010, 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. Bosken Park Shelter

**Adult Volunteers:** Monday, May 17, 2010, 5:30 – 8:30 p.m. Green Township Branch Library meeting room

**Cooking Class (optional but recommended):** TBA.

**Program Activities:**

Daisy, Brownie and Junior Girl Scouts: Songs, games, crafts, hikes, outdoor cooking and badge work.

Cadette Girl Scouts: Girl Scout Program Aide core training

**Transportation:** Provided by bus at the following locations: Our Lady of Visitation School, Taylor High School (lower lot).

**What to Wear:** A short-sleeve **T-shirt** and **shorts**. (Shirts should provide full coverage of stomach and back.) Gym shoes with closed toe, heel, and socks. (No sandals or clogs.) **Hat** or scarf. Please apply sunscreen and insect repellent before arriving at camp.

**What to Bring:** **In a school bag or backpack:** Unbreakable cup, rain gear, sit-upon, 2 large trash bags, one travel pack of wipes, one black Sharpie marker, water bottle, and any additional items as requested by individual unit leaders. **Label everything with camper's name.**

**Weather:** Please be aware that camp may be called off after the girls have arrived, if the director deems it necessary to insure the safety of the girls. **Please be sure your contact person will be available in the event that the camp is evacuated.**

**T-shirt:** T-shirts are included in the registration fee for all registered Girl Scouts and full-time adult volunteers. Part-time volunteers (working less than 5 days), boys, and preschool children can purchase a T-shirt for \$10.00 (this is optional). Be sure to order the correct size at the bottom of the Day Camp Site Information & Fee Form. Once t-shirts are ordered they **cannot** be returned or exchanged.

**Buddies:** Campers can designate **one** buddy (this is optional). Buddies **must** be in the same grade and **must** choose each other. **Buddies' registration forms must be received in the same envelope.** Buddies who do not choose each other and/or are not in the same grade will be disregarded. Remember that buddies are not a requirement! Many campers come to camp without a buddy and make new friends quickly.

**Medication:** Any over-the-counter or prescribed medications must be in the original container, labeled with child's name, and sent to the day camp nurse with written instructions on dosage and time to be administered. In certain cases, such as inhalers (which must be with the camper at all times) a note of necessity must be on file with the Camp Nurse.

**Day Camp Unit:** Day Camp is a "Beyond-the-Troop Experience." No more than 4 girls from the same troop will be placed in the same day camp unit. Campers will be contacted by their Unit Leaders at least 2 weeks prior to Day Camp. You will receive a letter informing you of the following: Unit Number, Unit Leader(s), and any additional supplies requested by Unit Leaders. Emergency phone numbers will also be included.

*In compliance with State requirements for day camps, we are providing parents/guardians with the child abuse reporting telephone numbers that we give to all volunteers and paid staff to ensure the safety of children.*

## IMPORTANT HEALTH INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS FROM GIRL SCOUTS OF WESTERN OHIO

In the past several years, cases of Lyme disease have been reported all across the United States. We feel that it is important for you and your family to know more about this disease. Lyme disease is transmitted by the bite of a tick.

The deer tick (found generally in the northeastern U.S.) and the western black-legged tick (found generally in the northwestern coastal states north of San Francisco) are so small that many people do not know that they have been bitten. The larger lone star tick is also a carrier in some Midwestern and southern states. The Pacific Coast tick and American dog tick may also be carriers. The symptoms include:

- A red rash or bump near the area of the bite. The reddish area expands in size and may become as large as 10 to 15 inches in diameter. Children often do not get this rash.
- Fever, chills, headache, fatigue.
- Enlarged lymph nodes.
- Stiff joints, particular in the knees.

If you suspect that your daughter has been bitten or has symptoms, have her see a physician immediately so that treatment can begin promptly. One or more weeks can pass between the time of a tick bite and the start of symptoms. For this reason we feel that you should have this information so that you can take prompt action if necessary.

Every precaution is taken by the event staff regarding the health and safety of our participants. If any person at camp discovers a tick on their skin, if possible it will be removed, put in a small container or taped to a piece of paper, and sent home. Parents/guardians should observe the suspected tick-bitten individual and contact their family physician if she shows any of the symptoms listed above. Take the tick with you so it might be tested for the disease.

An insect repellent containing 30 percent or less of DEET sprayed on clothing or bare legs and arms will help to repel ticks. A product with less than 20 percent DEET should be used on children. An adult should apply insect repellent to children prior to arrival at camp. **Insecticides should be sent to day camp with your daughter ONLY if she is capable of carrying and applying the insecticide herself. No day camp volunteer is permitted to apply insecticide to campers.** Long, light-colored pants tucked into socks will help to observe and remove ticks from clothing before they bite.
